Decides the following:

The Article -1-:

The Financial Services and Brokerage Company will receive an Annual Charge from each client in exchange for submitting the Service of Trading Through the Internet a Sum which does not increase (50,000) Fifty Thousand S.L only.

The Article -2-:

The Financial Services and Brokerage Company may not receive any Charge from any Client in exchange for submitting of this Service.

The Article -3-:

The over- mentioned charge will not include The Specific Charges of the Trading that each of the Commission, the Stock Exchange, and the Center will receive that are defined in “The Regulations of The Charges” which are specific for each of them.

And it does not include The Charges of Trading that the Company will receive and define in “The Act of Trading’s Charges of the Financial Services and Brokerage Companies.”
